(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs M. H. Clatworthy, all or two certain tracts of land, tract No. 1, containing Forty-five (45) acres, more or less, situated in Franklin Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid, in Mountain Creek, waters of Saluda River. Being the same tract which was conveyed by Mrs Martha C. Whitt, to P. Whitt, et al. to Mrs. M. Whitt, December 21, 1915, and by the said Geo. M. Whitt to the said Mary Roxie Whitt. For a definite description of this tract, see the first named deed, which is on record.

Tract No. 2. containing Forty-six (46) acres, more or less adjoining the above tract, and lying northwest of it, and on Mountain Creek, being the same tract conveyed by Mrs Martha C. Whitt, Geo. M. Whitt, Joe P. Whitt, et al to Cooley Whitt, December 21-1915. And conveyed by the said Cooley Whitt to the said Geo. M. Whitt, and by the said Geo. M. Whitt to the said Mary Roxie Whitt, together with the above named tract, in one deed, bearing date June 30th. 1921. Which deed is on record.
