All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, State of South Carolina and in the City of Greenville on the South side of West Broad Street and being more particularly described as follows to-wit:  
Beginning at a stake on the south side of West Broad Street in the west line of a 12 ft. alley, which point is 112 ft. in a westerly direction from the property line of South Main Street and running thence along the South side of West Broad Street N. 72-30 W. 46 ft. to an iron pin thence S. 17-30 W. 100 ft. to a stake on a 15 foot alley thence with the north line of said alley S. 72-30 W. 46 ft. to a 12 ft. alley; thence along the west line of said 12 ft. alley N. 17-30 E. 100 ft. to the beginning of the lot.
