Ocie M. Hill, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, consisting of one-half of that lot known and designated as Lot No. 10 in what is known as "Oakland Heights" and lying just beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at that corner of the said Lot No. 10 on Mountain View Avenue nearest the highway leading from Greenville toward Lamperville and extending back 116 feet to a 19 foot alley thence with said alley 50 feet thence 170' 6 feet northward to Mountain View Avenue, inver along Mountain View Avenue 50 feet to the beginning corner.

The premises herein conveyed are the same as conveyed to G. J. Lamar by G. J. Dlaughter by deed dated October 10, 1921 and recorded in Deed Book 62, page 369, R. M. C.
