In witness whereof, we, the undersigned, burgesses, town and common and other persons, do joint, bargain, sell and release unto the said
H.P. McGee and C.M. McGee, Trustees for Aileen McGee, Kay McGee Bull, Marguerite G. McGee,
Frederika P. McGee, B.M. McGee, Jr., and their successors & assigns:
all those certain pieces, parcels or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South
Carolina and County of Greenville, in Butler Township, about 11 miles from the City of Greenville
and on the west side of the road from Simpsonville to Betterville (referred to in previous
deed as the Old Augusta Road), being composed of four separate parcels of land which adjoin
each other and constitute one tract, containing forty-eight (48) acres, more or less. These
said tracts of land have collectively the following lines, notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the west side of the Old Augusta Road, and running
thence along the line of the one and a quarter (1 1/4) acre tract next hereinbefore referred to
as No. 1 to a post and a post-hole, thence N. 55° 2' W. 11.54 chains to a stake; thence S.
34° 45' E. 3.34 chains to a stake; thence N. 19° 1' W. 21.00 chains to a stake; thence N. 24° E.
4.13 chains to a stone on road leading to the old John Henderson home; thence S. 72° 2' E.
10.33 chains to a stone on the old Augusta Road; thence along said road S. 57° 2' E. 3.40 chains
to a stone on said road; thence N. 37° W. 11.25 chains to a bend in said road; thence along
said road N. 77° 34' E. 2.44 chains to the beginning corner; containing Forty-six and three-fourths
acres, more or less.

The fourth of said tracts intended to be hereby conveyed contains one and a quarter (1 1/4) acres
more or less, and is approximately triangular in shape and lies south-east of and adjoining
the 1/4 acre tract hereinabove described by courses and distances, being between the south
end of said tract and the said Old Augusta Road. These being the same tracts of land conveyed
to H.V. Sheppard by John C. Smith by deed dated December 8, 1916, and recorded in the R.W.C.
Office for Greenville County and State in Volume No. 41 of Leeds, at page 460, to which reference
is made and conveyed to us by H.V. Sheppard by deed dated January 1st, 1920, recorded in
P.A.L. Office for Greenville County in Book H, at page 152.

It is understood and agreed that H.P. and C.M. McGee, Trustees assume the payment of a note
and mortgage to Henry P. McGee dated January 1, 1920 for Six thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00);
interest paid to January 1, 1921, recorded in Vol. 23, page 12, R.W.C. Office for Greenville
County, South Carolina.
