the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
W. E. Rush, his heirs and assigns forever, All that
certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and
being on the West side of Aberdeen Avenue near the
corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in what is
affectionately known as the Cherry Property and being
Lot No. 19 in the plan of property of W. E.
Rush, Esq., trustee, made in the year 1924, said lot containing the following streets and
alleys, to wit:

beginning at an iron pin on the West side of
Aberdeen Avenue at a point four hundred, seventy
seven and five-tenth (477.5) feet South of the
intersection of Augusta Road and Aberdeen Ave.
and running thence with line of lot No. 18 N. 66° 24'
E. 162.5 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of
lot No. 20; thence with the rear line of lot No.
475, S. 25° 18' W. 162.5 feet to an iron pin rear
corner of lot No. 20; thence with line of lot No.
20, S. 66° 24' E. 164 feet to an iron pin on Aberdeen
Avenue, thence with Aberdeen Avenue N. 23° 26' E.
