the State of South Carolina, No. 10 - Calhoun Methodist
Episcopal Church, Box 100, Calhoun, Greenville County,
in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of
One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars,

to Edmund W. Webster, in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by C. E. Hissman witness of such sum, being my
deed instrument recd with receipt.

This day of December, 1910, I have granted, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Leo Fleming and Oney Fleming, their heirs and assigns forever, all that tract of
land in the County and State aforesaid, about two miles from Greenville County
Court House, near the Lowndes Hill Road, adjoining lands of myself, Holcombe, Maxwell
and others, containing Eight and 4/10 acres, more or less, being same as formerly
known as the Edmund Wiles tract, conveyed to me by J.W. Webster, formerly said to
contain Nine & 7/10 acres, more or less, and bounded as follows:
Beginning at a rock 3xnn, on the west side of the road leading from my house to the
big road 17 links from Mary Bates' iron pin and rock X; thence S. 65-2 W. 8-25 to a
rock X; thence S. 55-3/4 E. 2-65 to a rock 3xnn (Hammond's & Holcombe's X); thence
S. 28 E. 3-70 to a pin 3xnn; thence N. 56 E. 9-47 to a rock 3xnn (13 links west of
where the old X should be); thence N. 17-1/8 W. 7-71 to the beginning; this deed
excludes a strip to the T.P. Babb tract 13 links wide on the East side reserved for a
road, and being the same tract deeded to me by J.W. Webster, by his deed bearing date
July 1st, 1910 and recorded for Dec. 31st, 1909, recorded in Vol. 5, at page 325.
R.C.C. Greenville County in the State aforesaid.

pertaining.
