Barghout all that certain piece of land or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near in the City of Greenville described by Water and bounds as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the East side of Augusta Street near said City of Greenville One Hundred Twenty-three and $\frac{1}{2}$ feet from the Southwest corner of Augusta street and Grant's Avenue, running thence along the East side of Augusta Street South 45° 53' East Sixty-three feet to an iron post thence along the line of Lot Number Two (as shown on plat of property of C. H. and J. W. Garrison which plat is recorded in Plat Book "B" at page 126 in the Office of said County and State Surveyor) a certain flat of Eagle Park property North 42° 07' East One Hundred Sixty-seven and $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron post in West side of a fifteen foot alley thence along the West side of said alley South 53° 13' West Sixty-three feet to a stake thence South 43° 34' West One Thousand Fifty-one and $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the point of beginning.
