lot 116 at next door to me, parcel or lot of land
in Greenville Township, Greenville County,
State of South Carolina, and more particularly
described as follows:

Beguning at an iron pin on the north
side of Clough Avenue at corner of lot No.
116, as shown on a plat of East Park made
by W. W. Adams, July 1909 and recorded in
the R. M. C. official plat Book Greenville County
Plot Book "C" page 383, which lot No. 116 is
on east side property of R. N. Grisham, and
running thence with his line in a
northeastly direction 140 feet to line
of lot 117 sold to W. H. Cumpey; thence
with his line parallel with Clough Avenue
in a northwesterly direction 75 feet to a
stake in corner of line of G. B. Lee; thence
in a southwesterly direction in a parallel
with the first line above specified, 140
feet to a stake on Clough Avenue. Thence
west Clough Avenue \$155 E. 75 feet to the
beginning corner, embracing all the Southern
portion of lot No. 117 and the eastern half
of the southern portion of lot No. 118.
