the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

John Willis Marlar and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:
 "All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being just on the outside of the Town of Fountain Inn, in the County and State aforesaid, containing One and twelve one-hundredths of an acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-
 Bounded by John R. Harrison's Estate, road leading from Fountain Inn to Fairview and J.H.Nelson, 3.17 to an iron pin in the center of the road and running thence along said road N. 55° E. 47 W. 4.60 to an iron pin in the center of the road; thence N. 40 W. 3.17 to an iron pin; thence S. 47 W. 4.60 to an iron pin on John R.
