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THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 19th, day of March, 1926 by and between Huntington and Guerry, Incorporated, of the County of Greenville, State of South-Carolina hereinafter called Lessor, party of the first part, and the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, hereinafter called Lessee, party of the comond part, WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the rents and covenants herein contained, Lessor hereby leases unto Lessee lite successors and assigns, the following described premises with the appurtemances in the City of Greenville, State of South Caroline prowit: The entire of bor space of a ne story brick building, 50' x and the lot approximately 50 x 110, to the rear of said building, located on the East side of Hammond Street between Routh Main and River Streets for use as a storyroom and Barage, or for the general transaction of buginess. To have and to hold the same for the term of five (5) years organitus on the first day of Pebruary 1928, and shing on the thirty-first day of January 1931 at an annual rental of Pifteen hundred (\$1500.00) Tollars, payable in equal wonthly installments during the term hereof. Lessor agrees that Lessee may sub-let said premises to tenants not objectionable to lessor. Lessee agrees to maintain wild premises in as good condition as when received, ordinary wear, tadr and deterioration and damage by the elements or unavoidable casualty excepted, and to pay Lessor word rent as herein specified. Lessor corefants that said premises are suitable for the purposes leased, and hereby agrees to keep with predices in good and tenantable ophdition and to make at the portal own expense with repairs to any portion of said building as may be necessary to replaye faulty condituction of to replace all ordinate wear, toan and nevertorage of the painting of the whiside walls and painting papeling or tinting of the interior wayls a is necessary to maintain the building in reasonably good, andition and appearance and to make all changes and additions required by reason of kny law, ordinances, orders or regulations of any municipality, county, state or other public atcherities, including the furnishing of required sanitary facilities; and that should Lessor fail to make any of such repairs, replacements, painting, papering or tinting, or changes, within thirty days after written notice from Lessee of the necessity therefor, Lessee may, at its option, make the same and deduct the cost thereof from the rent next or at any time thereafter aggruing, or Lessee may quit and surrender possession of the premises without further liability to Lessee hereunder.

Lessee may make, from time to time, such interior changes, alterations, additions and improvements on the said premises as will, in the judgment of Lessee, better adapt the same to the purposes of its business. All fixtures added and improvements made in and to such premises by Lessee shall be at its own expense and shall remain the property of Lessee, and, upon the termination of this lease shall be removed from said premises by Lessee, Lessee shall, in the event of its making such interior changes, alterations or improvements, restore said premises, upon the termination of this lease, to the condition they were in when received bessee, ordinary wear, tear and deterioration and damage by the elements or unavoidable casualty excepted.

Lessee shall have the right to insure and keep insured at its own cost, its interest in the said premises to the extent of the cost of any interior changes, additions, alterations or improvements made by it thereon, and to collect the amount of any such insurance in the event of damage to or destruction of said additions, alterations or improvements during the term of this lease by any cause covered by such insurance; provided that such insurance shall not extend beyond the date of the termination of this lease.

Lessor shall pay all taxes, special assessments and public charges levied against said premises, payable during the term of this lease.

If the rent hereunder shall remain due and unpaid for ten (10) days after written notice from Lessor to Lessee, Lessor shall have the right to re-enter said premises and to remove all persons therefrom.

Lessow covenants that Lessee, upon paying the rent in the manner herein provided and performing the covenants aforesaid, shall and may peaceably and quietly have, hold and enjoy said premises for the term aforesaid.

Should said premises or any part thereof be destroyed by fire or otherwise, rendered untenantable, the rent payable hereunder shall abate from the date of such destruction or injury in the proportion that the premises so rendered untenantable bears to the entire premises, and all advance payments of rents, if any, covering periods subsequent to the date of story destruction or injury, shall be promptly refunded to Lessee, in the proportion aforesaid. Should a substantial part or the whole of the premises be so destroyed or rendered untenantable, Lessee may at its option guit and surrender possession of said premises hereby leased, or may, if it shall so desire, upon the completion of the repairs or restoration of said building, re-eccupy the premises upon the terms and conditions herein set forth, the rent to commence from the date of such re-occupation.

Lessee shall have the right to renew this lease, upon the same terms and conditions, for a further period of five (5) years from the date of the expiration of the primary term hereof, by giving written notice of its intention so to renew not less than thirty (30) days before the expiration of said primary term. Except that rental payable under the said renewal term shall be Nineteen Hundred Twenty (\$1920.00) Dollars per annum.

The premises herein described are situated on a railroad side track owned by the Lessor and it is understood and agreed that the Lessee may enjoy the use of these side track facilities for the purpose of handling its freight shipments.
