LEASE OF PETROLEUM VENDING PRIVILEGES.

(Rental Determined by Sales)

This Agreement, made this 18th day of December in the year 1930, by and between

R. A. Coker hereinafter called Lessor, and Standard Oil Company, of New Jersey, hereinafter called Lessee.

Witnesseth: Lesser does hereby demise and lease unto Lessee the exclusive right to store and sell gaseline, mater fuels, motor oil, grease and other petroleum products, all of which are hereinafter refersed to collectively as Petroleum Products, on the premises in the Town of Pelzer, R. F. D. #3, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described

One let of land situated in the above county and state beginning at the cerner of Old Hundred Road and Fork Sheals Road, extending fifty feet parallel with Old Hundred Read, thence 100 feet in an easternly direction, thence 50 feet in a westernly direction, thence 180 feet parallel with fork Sheals Read back to beginning point.

Lessee shall have the exclusive right and privilege of maintaining and using pumps, tanks and other facilities for the storage, sale and delivery of petroleum products and the servicing of automobiles at the prices on said premises where pumps, tanks and other facilities are now located on said premises. Lessee shall also have the exclusive use and eccupancy of an office and storage space 10 feet long and 10 feet wide, located at the front of the building on the premises herein described. Lessee shall also have the exclusive use and possession of the machinery, tools, furniture and appliances which are listed in the schedule herete attached and marked Schedule "A". Lessee, its employees, agents, customers and these having business with it whall have full, free and unrestricted ingress, te, egress from and access to and use of all of the spaces and facilities hereby lessed to Lessee.

To Held the premises hereby demised unto Lessee for the period of One Years
beginning on the 1st day of January 195D, and ending on the 31st day of December 1951, Lessee
paying therefor as rental each month an amount equivalent to one cent for each gallen of gasoline
and other meter fuels sold during the month at said premises by Lessee, its agents or assigns.
Payments of said rental are to be made on or before the tenth day of the month following the
menth in which the rental is earned. Lessee shall keef such books and records as will accurately
shew the mumber of gallens of gasoline and other moter fuels seld at the demised premises and
will permit Lesser to examine and inspect such books and records at any time and from time
to time when Lesser desires so to de.

The above letting is on the fellowing terms, conditions and covenants, Te-wit;

1. Lessur will not store or sell or permit anyone other than Lessee and its
employees, agents or assigns, to store or sell any petroleum products of any kind whatseever
at the premises herein described on in the streets adjacent thereto.

2. Lessee shall pay the specified rent at the times and in the manner provided

5. Lesser agrees to pay all taxes and assessments now or hereafter levisd against said premises. Should Lessor fail to pay such taxes or assessments when due and payable, Lessee shall have the right to pay the same and may withheld from any rentals payable hereunder as they acopue, such amounts as may be necessary to fully reimburse Lessee.

4. Lessee may install, move and remove at and from the premises hereby leased to it such tanks, pipes, pulms, equipment, machinery and other facilities for the storing, handling and selling of petroleum products and servicing automobiles as shall in its epinion be necessary in order to use said premises for its business of storing, handling and selling of petroleum products. Lessee may paint the tanks, pumps, machinery and other equipment
