McMahamin the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. D. McMaham his heirs and assigns foreverall that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greene Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On waters of Grace Creek and Saluda River and having the following metes and bounds as shown by plat made by C. St. Millard, Engineer, February 1925. Beginning at an iron pin on plantation road corner of tract of land owned by J. G. Williams (or formerly owned by J. G. Williams) and running thence west plantation road N. 25-30 E. 278.2 feet to iron pin corner of Williams land, thence west his line N. 64-30 W. 248 feet to iron pin thence again with Williams line N. 25-30 E. 228 feet to intersection of old road location and road to (Edmont; thence with old road location N. 42-10 W. 307 feet to a stake; thence still with old road location N. 64-30 W. 396.2 feet to a stone; thence still with old road location N. 25-30 W. 304.4 feet to stone on; thence S. 27-40 W. 66.5 feet to stone on McMaham's corner, thence with his line S. 75-37 E. 344.6 feet to iron pin, thence with line of Major Davis' (formerly J. G. Williams land) S. 64-19 E. 828.4 feet to the beginning corner. The above tract is composed of the tract containing four and twenty-five hundredths (4.25) acres, more or less conveyed to J. G. Williams by Anna Mitchell July 27th, 1915. said deed is recorded in Deed Book 38 page 393, G. M. C. office for Greenville County and the portion of the land devised to J. G. Williams by Anna Mitchell by will dated August 28th, 1915 and recorded in office of Probate Judge for Greenville County on January 10th 1917 in will book M pages 73 and 74.

This entire tract contains 13.79 acres which is hereby conveyed.
