In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. H. Bailes, all my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-half interest of, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the south side of South Main Street, in the city of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron Pin on the south side of said street and the northwest corner of lot now of Conrad, formerly of Drane and running thence with South Main Street in a westerly direction, 76.3 feet to the northeast corner of lot conveyed by B. T. Owen and B. C. Grier to Green Drug Company; thence with line of said Green Drug Company lot S. 12-42 E. 150 feet; thence N. 77-18 E. 119.7 feet to an iron Pin on Conrad's line; thence with Conrad's line N. 28-07 W. 167 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

The above described lot of land is the same conveyed by A. E. Morris to C. C. Hindman, J. H. Bailes, John Frank and J. D. Richardson by deed dated April 16, 1920, recorded in Book 63, page 581 and the said C. C. Hindman conveyed his undivided one-fourth interest to John Frank by deed dated February 13, 1923, recorded in Book 78, page 498.

As the consideration for this conveyance the grantee herein agrees to cancel and return to the grantor the notes and the four mortgages securing them executed by C. C. Hindman, et al., to A. E. Morris, on April 16, 1920, the mortgages securing said note being recorded in the office of R. M. C. for said County in mortgage Book 96, page 1; Book 96, page 2; Book 96, page 3; Book 91, page 59 and Book 91, page 60. It being distinctly understood and agreed that this conveyance is in full settlement and discharge of all claims and demands which the said J. H. Bailes may have against John Frank and C. C. Hindman growing out of the ownership, by them of the above described lot of land.

It is understood and agreed that the grantee herein assumes payment of all taxes against the above described lot of land.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by on the day of, 1926, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds for Greenville County, in Book , Page .  
TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said J. H. Bailes, his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. H. Bailes, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
