and assigns: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the East side of Pettigru Street, having a frontage of 50 feet and a depth of 176 feet on one side and 175 feet on the other and being 76 feet wide at the rear, being shown on plat of East Park in Plat Book "A" at page 553 as Lot No. 141 in Block "E".

Judson Mills: All that certain tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and lying just north of the Easley Bridge Road, and west of the P. & N. Railroad Tracks, described by metes and bounds as follows:
