 ing in the County and State aforesaid, and bounded on the North side of the City of Greenville on
 the South side of Washington Street and having
 long boundary running south bounds to west:
 commencing at an iron pipe on South side of
 Washington Street corner of Player lot, said pipe
 being 10' west distance from the West side of
 Player lot; running along South side of Washington
 Street 9' 10" W. of pipe, to an iron pipe, thence
 running N. 60° E. 10' distance from pipe to 17. 20' West
 of pipe, to stone in wall nine, thence in N. 60° E. 50' to
 the corner stone; thence along Player's line N. 17. 20'
 E. 13' 10" to the point of beginning; thence along
 the 13' 10" lot of lands purchased by E. T. Baugatton
