IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties to this instrument, have signed their names to this instrument in the presence of each other, and to witness the sealing of this instrument by **Troyon Development Company**, a corporation chartered and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, having its principal office in the County of Greenville, at a branch office at Troyon, S.C., and

the above instrument is fully acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and delivered unto the said **Troyon Development Company**, the following lot or parcel of land lying and being in Glancy Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and Troyon, S.C., and bounded as follows:

Beginning at a stone on the state line, William Gillettes corner (now corner of Gillette State Incorporated); thence with said state line N. 86° E. 28 poles to a stake and pointers; thence S. 56° East 30 poles to a stake on the Old Fox Farm Road; thence with said road forty four feet 28 poles to an oak in the low gap; thence N. 67° East 32 poles to the beginning, containing 2174 acres, more or less.

The above mentioned land was conveyed to said Allen Jersey by deed from L.F. Blackwell of date 1921, 1921, said deed being of record in the office of Register of Deeds, Greenville, South Carolina in Vol. 71, of Deeds, at page 457.
