E. W. Blackman, J. Lynn Walker and A. H. Gregory
as Trustees, all that certain lot of land situated
on the northeast corner of Earle and Townes
Streets, in the City of Greenville, County of
Greenville, State aforesaid and having the following
miles and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on said southwest
corner of said streets and running thence with
Townes Street b. 5½ w. two hundred (200) feet to
a stake; thence n. 84½ w. sixty (60) feet to a stake
corner of lot of A. J. Rauch, thence with lines
of A. J. Rauch n. 5½ e. two hundred (200) feet to a
stake on Earle Street; thence with said
Street b. 94½ e. sixty (60) feet to the beginning
corner and being the same lot heretofore conveyed
to me by Isabell Cohen by deed dated 28th
day of June 1924 and recorded in the Register
office for Greenville County in volume 86 page
87.

In trust, nevertheless, to keep said property in repair and to suffer
and permit whosoever may from time to time be pastor of
Central Baptist Church of Greenville, S. C. to occupy said
premises as a home with full power in said Trustees
to borrow such sums of money upon such terms as they
may deem advisable and to secure the repayment of
such sums by mortgaging said property and with free
power in said trustees to at any time sell and convey said property by
good and simple deed upon such terms and at such price as they
may deem fit, and to make the purchase of said property to receive a good and sufficient price therefor
