J. P. Ballenger his heirs and assigns, all that
 certain piece parcel or lot of land situate lying
 in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid
 located on N. W. side of Smith Avenue, near Greenville
 S.C., commencing at an iron pin two hundred and
 nine feet from Laurens Road, corner of lot 60.
 thence N. W. direction one hundred and nineteen feet
 to iron pin on line of lot no. 59; thence in a
 western direction fifty feet, thence along lines
 of lots no. 61 and no. 62 one hundred and sixteen
 feet to an iron pin on Smith Avenue; thence in
 a northwesterly direction along Smith Avenue

 TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appur-
 taining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said *J. P. Ballenger*, his

heirs, and assigns, forever.
