(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said A. B. Stodgenes his heirs and assigns all that piece or parcel of land situated in the County and State aforesaid containing twenty acres, more or less, and is fully described in the deed to W. M. Stodgenes by Thaddeus Stodgenes dated the 17th day of March 1906 and recorded in Vol. 117 page 109 to which reference is made as a part of this description:

1. All that piece or parcel of land adjoining the above containing five and three-fourths acres, more or less, and fully described in the deed to Thaddeus Stodgenes by W. B. Trotter by deed dated 20th day of March 1906, to which reference is made as a part of this description:

All that piece or parcel of land beginning at a point in the Franklin Road and running thence along the center of said Road N. 23 1/2 E. 3. 59; thence N. 13 1/2 E. 11. 30 along the center of said road; thence N. 49 W. 1. 84 to a stone on thence N. 49 1/4 W. 15. 41 to stones on thence S. 59 1/4 E. 19. 38 to 11. 8 acres.

Upon condition, which is a condition subsequent to-wit: that the said A. B. Stodgenes will give adequate and comfortable board and lodging a place near home, to the said W. M. Stodgenes, provide necessary medical and nursing attention and medicines and after payment of taxes, insure two hundred dollars per year, all of the above to be had and done each year so long as I shall live. Upon the further condition, which is a condition subsequent, that in the event the said A. B. Stodgenes predeceases me, then as a charge against the land above described, I shall be provided comfortable and adequate board and lodging, medical and nursing attention and medicines and he paid the sum of two hundred dollars per year in like manner during my life as above provided and upon failure on the part of the said A. B. Stodgenes or his heirs executors or administrators to fully and adequately perform the conditions or anyone of them above provided the title to the land shall revert to me or my heirs without any act of conveyance or other instrument to vest said title again in me.
