Jackson*, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville on the South side of East Earle Street and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the South side of East Earle Street, three hundred ninety-two feet four inches from the Eastern line of Elizabeth Street, running thence South 18-30 West two hundred, six feet six inches to a stake; thence South 71-20 East sixty-five feet five inches to a stake; thence North 18-30 East two hundred six feet six inches to a stake on the South line of Earle Street; thence along South line of Earle Street North 71-20 West sixty-five feet and five inches to the beginning corner, being bounded on the East by lot now or formerly owned by J.R.
