that certain piece parcel or lot of land  
situate and lying in Greenville Township, State and  
County aforesaid, about three miles from Greenville Court  
House "near Cookie Store, on the east side of Old White  
Horse Road, and having the following courses and  
dimensions:

beginning at a stake on the east side of the  
Old White Horse Road, 270 feet from W. E. Rushton's  
corner; thence along the lot sold by J. H. Wilbanks  
to James Lowry Simpson, and running thence with  
her line S. 76 10' E. 170 feet to stake; thence S.  
13° W. 50 feet to stake; thence N. 76 10' W. 170 feet  
to stake on east side of Old White Horse Road;  
thence with said Road N. 69 30' E. 50 feet to the
