(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said H. P. Blane and G. M. Rice, Trustees of 2-4th School District and their successors in office forever, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Easttown Township, State and County aforesaid, containing Sixty-one (61) acres, more or less, bounded by, and containing the old school lot and lands of myself, Mary Williams, part of that certain tract of land, conveyed to me by my late husband, dated February 29, A.D. 1924 and recorded in the Office of Register of Deeds, Conveyances for Greenville & Spartanburg, page 320, for \$200.00, and being described as follows: "The said lot of land, see Section 6, 100 feet of the whole school lot as made, by B.
