(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Minerva Bates, her heirs and assigns, all our right, title and interest in the house Place of Susan Smith, deceased, in Chest Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on Marionbone Creek, about a mile from a place station being all that remains of the land conveyed by Elizabeth Walker to Susan Smith by deed dated April 21, 1875 recorded in the Reg. L. Office of said Greenville County in Book 99 page 77, after three fractions which Susan Smith held by the deducted this deed is intended to convey all of the land in said Greenville County owned by Susan Smith at the time of her death, and the grantee and grantee are all the heirs at law of said Susan Smith except Emily Walker who is now deceased and Arthur Walker and Clifton Walker grantee above named are her children and who represent her interest.

As a part of consideration of this deed the following trusts are imposed on the grantee first, that Joseph Smith the husband of the deceased Susan Smith, is to have possession of this above described land during his life, second, that the grantee is to pay the taxes on the premises, third, that the remainder of the said land after the death of Joseph Smith is to be the exclusive property of the grantee Minerva Bates her heirs and assigns free from all trust.
