For and in consideration of the sum of \$2500.00 Dollars, to the Tryon Development Company, its successors, heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors and all persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof...

RESIDENCE, GARAGE, OR OTHER BUILDING WHATSOEVER shall be erected on said lot until, and unless, the plans and specifications thereof have been submitted to and approved by the grantor herein...

FIFTH: That no more than one residence shall be erected on each lot or parcel as shown by said plat, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in addition to one residence, there may be erected a garage and servants' quarters...

SIXTH: That the parties hereto, their successors, heirs and assigns, will not, during the term of twenty-one years from April 1, 1925, subdivide, sell or convey any part or parcel of said lots...

EIGHTH: That no surface closet or other unsanitary device for the disposal of sewage shall ever be installed or maintained on the lot herewith conveyed, unless the same is approved by the grantor herein...
