all that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near Judson Mills, known as lot No. 83 in Plat of Property of Pride & Patten Land Company made by R. C. Dalton, Engineer, recorded in office of R. M. C. for said County in Plat Book 6, Page 249, and having the following courses and distances: Beginning at an iron Pin on Goodrich Street, 52 feet from the corner of an unnamed street, corner of lot No. 84, thence with line of said lot 36-15 m 220 feet to iron Pin, corner of lot 46; thence with line of said lot 36-15 m 23 w. 60.3 feet to iron Pin, corner of lot 22; thence with line of said lot 36-15 m 214.2 feet to iron Pin on Goodrich Street; thence with Goodrich Street 154-71 s. 49 feet to the beginning.

also all that other lot of land in township, County and State aforesaid, near Judson Mills, known as Part lot 84 on the Plat there referred to, and having the following courses and distances: Beginning at a stake on Goodrich Street, 51.3 feet west of the corner of lot No. 84, as shown on said Plat, and running thence with Goodrich Street 31.64-4.9 m 54 feet to corner of lot 83; thence with line of said lot 36-15 m 220 feet to iron Pin, corner of lot 45; thence with line of said lot 36-15 m 23 w. 50 feet to stake which stake is 10.7 feet from the original line of lot No. 84; thence 36-15 m 224 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, being all of lot No. 84 as shown on said Plat, except a strip fronting 5.3 feet on Goodrich Street and 10.7 feet back at the back, which strip is reserved for street purposes to be used in connection with the street laid out by J. M. Hartman on his property lying east of the Pride & Patten Land Company Subdivision.
