In hand, duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,  
 lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the Township, on the South side  
 of Service Drive, with the following notes and boundaries:  
 Beginning at a stake in the corner of Lot #12, and  
 running thence with Service Drive S. 13° 10' E. 50 feet to  
 the curve in the road, thence S. 19° 48' East 50 feet to  
 a stake, thence with the line of Lot #16, S. 35° 34' 26.  
 716 feet to the corner of Lot #25; thence 11° 05' N. 12° 48'  
 E. 50 feet to the corner of Lots 25 and 12; thence with the  
 line of Lot #12, N. 37° 38' E. 190 feet to the point of  
 the beginning.

Lot - Being Lot #14, Section A, development of Caesar  
 Head, as recorded in Plat Book A, at Page #122.

1. That the premises shall be used for residential purposes only and that the owner or occupant shall at all times conform to all sanitary and police regulations that may be adopted by the directors of the corporation.
2. That the property shall not be sold, leased or rented to anyone except white persons.
3. The "Company" reserves the right to enclose Section A, or any part thereof, of the Company's Development, being the section on which the head and lot is situated, within a permanent fence and establish and maintain a toll gate or gates at which all persons may be required to pay reasonable admission fees to said Section A, provided however, that no charge shall be made to the owners of the lots within said enclosure, their families and guests to all of which terms said parties hereto agree.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
