to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee..... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

J. E. Kitchen, R. G. Rosenword and H. L. Cox, as Trustees of Welcome School District no 6-C of Greenville County, S. C.

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known as lots nos 97, 98, 109, and 110 on plat of Westview Height made by Dalton & Neve, Engineers, in July, 1925, and recorded in Plat Book 2, page 33, in Office of A. M. C. for said County having the following courses and distances, according to said plat:

Beginning at iron pin on the west side of King Street corner of lot 99; and running thence with King Street N. 46° 34' 36" 122 feet to iron pin corner Valley Street, thence with Valley Street S. 43° 30' 30" feet to iron pin, corner W. M. Burn Avenue; thence with W. M. Burn Avenue S. 46° 34' 6" 122 feet to iron pin, corner of lot no 111; thence with line of lot 111 and N. 43° 30' 6" 300 feet to beginning corner, being part of the same conveyed to Pride & Patton Land Company by American Bent & Trust Company, April 13, 1925, recorded in Deed Book 72, page 380.

This conveyance is made subject to the following conditions:

1. No house is to be built on any of Pride & Patton Land Co. lots to cost less than \$1200.00.

2. Right reserved to lay and place on, authorize the laying and placing of sewer, gas and water pipes, telegraph, telephone and electric light poles, and street car tracks on or in any of the streets on said plat without compensation or consent of any lot owner.

3. No building to be erected nearer the sidewalk than 10 feet, as indicated by building line shown on plat.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee..... hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee..... hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
