All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 11.3 acres, more or less, adjoining lands now or formerly of Stigge, League, Graham, Gilbert and J. M. Verdin, being that portion on the south side of the Anderson Bridge Road of the tract of land conveyed to J. M. Verdin by S. G. and S. F. Fowler, conveyed to them by J. C. Fowler and others by deed recorded in office of R. M. L. for Greenville County in Deed Book 38-24-24, at page 683 being a part of the J. F. Fowler home place and more fully described as follows,

to the end against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
