a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of \$100,000.00 Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto,

W. T. Wheeler his heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Oaklawn Township, County and State aforesaid, containing twenty-three and thirty-four one hundredths acres (23.34 1/100), more or less being lot no. 4 of a sub-division of the Pinckney Place made by Ed. A. Ellis, March 28, 1930, having the following bounds and metes:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Anderson line thence S. 64° 6.800 to an iron pin thence S. 37 1/2 W. 29.00 to River and along said River to an iron pin thence N. 37 1/2 E. 64.700 to beginning corner being part of the hundred and fourteenth acre tract of land deeded to the Chicora Bank by L.
