division known as Overbrook, near the Overbrook Report  
and being a portion of Lots Nos. 2 and 1 of a survey

1917, beginning at a point on street in lot  
No. 2, 10 feet from the corner of lots Nos. 2 and 1, thence  
S. 44-19 E. 50 feet to iron pin; thence N. 45-11 E. 28.75


