in hand paid us and before the sealing of these presents by P. S. Huntington and Dupont Guerry Jr.

the within named persons have executed Bargains, Sold and Relented, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said P. S. Huntington and Dupont Guerry, Jr.:
 certain triangular strip or piece of land situated and being in the City of Greenville, S. C., in Carolina, on the East side of Broad Street, and having, according to plat made up, taken and Surveyed, Engineers, December 21st, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
 beginning at an iron pin on Hammond Street corner of property of the grantee and running thence with said Hammond Street S. 28-17 E. 1 ft. to a stake, thence N. 54-08 E. 99-6 ft. to another stake in lot of 10 foot alley; thence S. 51-56 W. 9-9 ft. to the point beginning.
 It is understood by and between the parties that this strip of land together with other land now owned by the grantee is to be used as a party alley and that it shall be for the benefit of the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns. Provided, however, that in the event John O'Rourke and Sarah M. O'Rourke do not pay, or cause to be paid, Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollar note and mortgage when due, incurred over a triangular strip of land conveyed to them by Huntington and Guerry, that the use of the said party alley shall rest absolutely in the grantees, their heirs and assigns, and the grantors, their heirs and assigns, shall have no further interest whatsoever in said strip of land or the party alley herein referred to.
