The above instrument fully witnessed, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Received, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
H. B. Ellis, Jr.,
All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and
being in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, on the
West side of Ridgeland Avenue, and being known and
designated as lot No. 17, on Cleveland Terrace, according
to a plat made by Walter G. Rivers, 1926, and having the
following written and bounded, to wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Ridge-
land Avenue 40 feet east of lot No. 16 and 17, and
running thence with Ridgeland Avenue the following
courses and distances, to wit: E. 34° 24' 34.611 feet thence
N. 57° 42' 21.11 feet, thence N. 81° 29' 63.7 feet, thence N.
86° 19' 21.36 feet to an iron pin on Ridgeland Avenue,
corner of lot No. 18, thence with the line of that lot
N. 4° 56' 06.371 feet to an iron pin on an alley, corner
of lot No. 16, thence with line of that lot, E. 76° 46' E.
1162.3 feet to the point of beginning.

any point. (2) No dwelling shall be built on said property costing less
than \$8,500.00 (this shall not, however, apply to any servant house which
shall be used in connection with the dwelling). (3) The property herein
conveyed shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any per-
son or persons having any percentage of negro blood. (4) The property
herein conveyed shall be used only for residential purposes.

do hereby bind

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said.

H. B. Ellis, Jr., his
heirs and assigns, against
myself and my
heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
