as full consideration for the above sum of Ten Dollars, paid and received and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
J. Warren Mitchell the following described Property to-wit:

lot No. 11 in Section 20 of said tract of land situate, lying
and being in the City of Greenville, County and State
aforesaid, on the North side of Harcourt and being
E. 100' and designated as lot No. 11 as shown on a
Plan of Harcourt recorded in the R.M.L. office for
Greenville County in Plan Book "F" at Page 284, and
Pursuant to said Plan the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron Pipe on the North side of
Harcourt St. (S. E. corner of Bennett St. cut), joint corner
of lots 10 and 11, and running thence with joint
line of said lots N. 17-58 E. 149.4 feet to an iron Pipe
thence N. 72-02 E. 68 feet to an iron Pipe, joint corner
of lots 10 and 11, thence along joint line of
said lots N. 17-58 E. 149.4 feet to an iron Pipe on
Harcourt, thence northward Harcourt N. 72-02 E. 68
feet to point of beginning, said lot is composed of
parts of land bounded to the left as follows and
is in Cleveland.

A right-of-way two (2) feet in width at the
center of said lot is reserved for the erection of
telephone and electric light poles and lines.

Subject to the following restrictions, which are hereby
declared to be exclusively for the benefit of all Persons
owning lots on the Plat above referred to (1). The
Property shall never be sold, rented, or otherwise disposed
of to Persons having a Percentage of negro blood. (2) no
building shall be erected on said lot nearer to Harcourt than
thirty feet, and only one dwelling shall be erected on said lot, except one tenant
house may be placed on the rear of said lot. (3) The Property shall be used exclusively
for white religious purpose and no filling station, store or apartment house shall ever be
placed on said lot.
