land, in and situated and being in Greenville
County, Greenville Township, State of South Carolina
just outside the corporate limits of City of Green-
ville and being known and designated as
lot # 65, according to plat of Overbrook Land
Company property (September 17, 1913, recorded in
L. M. C. Office Greenville County, in Plat Book 6, at
page 251-252, dater and accepting therefrom)
a strip of land five feet in width across
the east end of said lot, and the part herein
described - having the following metes and
bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the
south line of Overbrook Circle, which point is
