C., about one and one-half miles from Greenville Court-house, on the west side of the Burnsville Road and described as follows: Beginning at corner of lots 200 and 207 on said Burnsville Road, and running thence about 21 feet S 50-30 W to corner of lots 206 and 213; thence along side of lot 214 six (6) feet; thence across with the first line 204 feet to Burnsville Road; thence with said Road six (6) feet to the beginning corner.
