Neely an undivided one-half interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

about one and one-half miles from the City of Greenville, on the East side of Burcombe Road, and having the following miles and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the line of the American Spinning Company, 104 East from the Burcombe Road, and running thence S. 76 1/2 E. 55 feet along the line of American Spinning Company to an iron pin, thence N. 2 1/2 W. 40 feet to an iron pin on line of Mrs. W. R. Neely, thence N. 84 1/2 W. 55 feet along Mrs. Neely's line to an iron pin, thence S. 11 1/2 W. 40 feet to an iron pin on the American Spinning Company's line, the beginning corner.
