demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 20th day of May, 1926 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinabove mentioned and described, be conveyed by C. Inman, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to J. M. Taylor,

Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

J. M. Taylor, his heirs and assigns forever, all the right title and interest of the Master defendants, William Brown, Louis Brown and Lee Brown, in and to the following described real estate:
All that certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Hickory Springs Township, near the Town of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, containing 8.3 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Edwards, Edwards and Taylor, and being the lands owned by Taylor at the time of his death, and having according to Plat made by W. R. Morris, December 30, 1925, the following lines and bounds, to-wit, Beginning at a stone on the north side of the road leading to Edwards, thence westward running thence N. 60° E. 20.40 to a stone, thence N. 75° E. 14.00 to the iron rim, thence N. 25.30 E. 9.00 to a stone, thence N. 6.30 E. 4.70 to a stone, thence N. 84° E. 3.60 to a stake, thence S. 18° E. 8.25 to a stony corner of Edwards lands, thence S. 46° W. 6.15 to a stone, thence S. 47 1/2 W. 6.75 to a stake, thence S. 25° W. 5.72 to a stone, thence S. 41 1/4 W. 8.70 to a stone, thence S. 30° E. 9.07 to a stone, thence S. 54° 40' W. 8.46 to an iron ring on road to Taylor, thence S. 50° 45' W. 13.85 to a post Oak Edwards corner, thence with his line N. 31.20 W. 26.68 to the point of beginning.
