demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 11th
 day of October 1926 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
 adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be conveyed by E. Isman
 Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Lug. W. Smith,

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Isman,
 Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon payment by Lug. W. Smith
 of \$2.00 to Ella Granger, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said
Lug. W. Smith, his heirs and assigns,
 all the right title
 and interest (the same being and undivided, three tenths
 interest) of Ella Granger op, in and to, all that piece
 parcel of lot of land in East Tant Township, Greenville
 County, South Carolina, beginning at a stone 38nm in
 old Grimes Road, and running thence E 80° 20' 17.90'
 11'-6.6' 37' 8m. on branch; thence E 22° 10' 35.0' to
 line 37' 8m. thence S 73° E 18.60' to stone in old Grimes
 Road 37' 8m; thence S 73° E 18.60' to stone in old Grimes
 Road 37' 8m; thence 47.6 E 12.10' to beginning point, con-
 tinuing 10.50' acre, a one fifth interest in the
 above described land was devised to Ella
Granger, her Mother Minnie Granger, see
 Deed with #7, file 110 in office of County Judge
 for said County and a one tenth interest was
 conveyed to Ella Granger by E. Granger,
 Executor, and E. Granger by deed dated
 November 26, 1919, recorded in Book 56, page 276.

 and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Lug. W. Smith, his
 heirs and assigns forever.
