WHEREAS, H. A. Simons

on or about the 21st day of August in the year of
 our Lord nineteen hundred and sixty exhibited his complaint in the Court
 of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against James E. Walker and Samuel A. Tanguay

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 27th
 day of April, 19th, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
 adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by B. Simons
 Master in and for the County aforesaid, to H. A. Simons for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear: (See Judgment Roll No. 6421)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, B. Simons

Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said H. A. Simons the premises and assigns, the following described real estate, to-wit: "all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Butler's corner in Greenville County State of S.C., on branch water of Moore River, beginning at a stake on the road leading from Greenville to Mauldin, thence S. 83° E. 28' 0" to rock on George McRae's line, thence N. 28° E. 22' 0" due west to a stake on the four branch thence down said branch 29' 67 chains to a rock post, Peakers corner, thence along said road 29' 35' chain to the beginning corner, and containing 1.12 acres more or less, being bounded by lands of J. H. Peaker, Brown Creek, R. H. Mathis et al." This being the same tract of land conveyed under order of court in judgment roll 10667 by T. L. Southwick, Master to D. L. Tanguay, who never recorded his deed, and was conveyed by D. L. Tanguay to H. A. Simons by deed dated 18 Feb. 1906 and recorded in Deed Book 78 p. 112, page 606.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, to all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said H. A. Simons his heirs and assigns forever.
