HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said L. A. Harvey and Mary Starney and their heirs and assigns forever, the

described real estate:
 "All that certain lot of land in the Town of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on the south side of Maud Street and being known and designated as Lot no. 12 according to Plat of Minnie Tocoah Gaines' Property made for John A. Robinson, Agent, by W. A. Christopher, Surveyor, June 14, 1923, and having the following lines and bounds and courses and distances, as follows by said Plat, to wit: Beginning at an iron Pin on the south side of Maud Street, Northeast corner of lot no. 11 and running thence along the line of said lot S. 13 E. 209 feet to a Point in the rear line of lot no. 17, thence along the rear lines of lots 17 and 18 N. 71.45 E. 70 feet to corner of lot no. 13; thence along the line of this lot N. 13 W. 204.4 feet to a Point in line of Maud Street, thence along the line of said street S. 76 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner and being a part of the land owned by Minnie Tocoah Gaines at the time of her death."
