I, E. Inneman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, M. L. Burdette, individually and as Executor
of the last Will and Testament of Isabella Dawson,
deceased

on or about the 15th day of September In the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and Twenty-Six exhibited his
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against B. W. Burdette, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 4th
day of February A.D. 1926, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinbefore mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inneman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to M. L. Burdette
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear: (See Judgment Roll No.)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, W. B. McElroyan, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$41.66,
HAVE GRANTED, CONVEYED AND RELEASED, and by these presents, DO GRANT, CONVEY AND RELEASE unto the said M. L. Burdette,

his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title
and interest of Isabella Burdette, in and to the
following described real Estate:

"All that certain tract of Parcel of land
situate, lying, and being in the County and State
aforesaid, and more particularly described as
follows: to wit: Beginning at an ash tree on the

branch at the corner of Thomas O. Burdette's land,
and running thence north, northeast to a stone
corner near gin house: thence East, Southeast,
along the George Academy Road to a red oak: thence
southeast to the corner of Thomas League and
Jewell Baldwin: thence in a westerly direction
to a Maple on the south fork of the branch: thence
continuing said westerly course, leaning slightly
to the north, to a holly: thence in same direction
to the beginning corner containing 45 acres, more
or less.

This being the same property devised to M. L.
Burdette and Isabella Burdette, by the will of Isabella
Dawson. See Decree of court in the case of M. L.
Burdette individually and as Executor of the last
Will and Testament of Isabella Dawson, deceased
against B. W. Burdette, et al. now on file in the
office of Clerk of Court for Greenville County."

and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-
fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said M. L. Burdette his heirs and assigns forever.
