WHEREAS, Buller French, et al

on or about the 12th day of February, in the year of
 our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty, exhibited their complaint in the Court
 of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against D. C. French, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 31st
 day of May, 1930, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
 adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Lissman
 Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Llewlee T. Woollard,
 for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-1944)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Lissman,
 Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Llewlee T. Woollard, the following described
 real estate:
 All that certain tract of land in Dunklin
 Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 131 acres, more or less, and known and
 designated as Tract no 3, according to a sub-division
 and plat of the estate of Jesse D. French,
 made by Walton & Neves Engineers in April
 1930. Said tract of land is bounded by Tracts
 nos 1, 3 and 5 of the plat above mentioned and
 has such meter and bounds and courses
 and distances as will appear by reference
 to the above plat, which is of record in
 the R. M. C. Office for the County and State
 aforesaid, in Plat Book G, page 270.

The above tract of land represents the
 divided interest of the grantee, as fixed by the
 Court in the Partition Suit herein, under which
 this deed is made.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
 and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right,
 fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Llewlee T. Woollard,
 his heirs and assigns forever.
