to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto F. B. Massingale, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situated, lying and being on the South side of Hampton Avenue SW Ward (cont'd) of the City of Greenville, and having the following described boundaries to wit:

Beginning at a point on the South side of Hampton Avenue, fifty four (64) feet from the east side of Frank Street, and running thence along the South side of Hampton Avenue, the 3rd st. 45 feet, the same which lies to G. O. Rainey's Garrison line on Pine Street, thence along Pine Street, 1 3/4 3.72 feet, more or less, thence along a line parallel with G. O. Rainey's line, One Hundred and three (103) feet more or less, to the beginning corner, said lot having width of Fifty four (64) feet and running from Hampton Avenue to Pine Street.
