to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinabove named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto James F. Lamphard his heirs and assigns,

the following described land, situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, County and State of South Carolina, property of E. B. F. Land Development Company, said tract first recorded in the Office of Register of Deeds, Greenville, S. C., in book Book L, at page 24, and more particularly described on said plat as follows:

beginning at a point on Fairview Avenue, front corner, lot #57 and #58, thence along joint line of said lots to lot #55, 180 feet to a point on rear of lot #55, thence along rear of lots #52 and #51, N. 45° 15' E, 26 feet to corner of lot #59, thence along joint line of lots #52 and #59, N. 35° 40' E, 180 feet to point on Fairview Avenue, thence along line of Fairview Avenue, S. 45° 15' E, 20 feet to the beginning corner.
