2. Also all that other certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying, situate and being in the State and County aforesaid on the East side of C. G. R. R., consisting of 10 acres, more or less and being the same conveyed to Greenville Trust Co. by Lavanie Blam, Aug. 29, 1910, deed recorded in Vol. 6, page 137, reference to which is erased for metes and bounds.
