NOW, therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars,

to me paid by the said Roy H. Bogeman, as Receiver for The Bank of Commerce

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Roy H. Bogeman, as Receiver for the Bank of Commerce, his successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

"All that tract of land situate in Dunklin Township, County And State aforesaid, containing 119⁵/₈ acres, more or less, Beginning at a stone near the ash, at the junction of a branch with Horse Creek at the corner of Tract no. 2 of J.W. Ridgway lands and runs thence N. 64³/₂ E. 12.00 to a Point on branch, thence N. 77¹/₂ E. 2.80 up said branch; thence N. 71⁴/₂ E. 8.00 to stone; thence N. 53³/₂ E. 8.72 to stone on old road; thence N. 4 W. 6.07 to stone; thence N. 64³/₂ E. 8.00 to a Point on gully; thence N. 45³/₂ E. 1.79 to head of branch; thence N. 24³/₂ E. 2.86 to Point on branch; thence N. 53³/₂ E. 1.86 to Cherry on branch; thence N. 68 E. to stone, at junction of branch; thence along branch N. 48 W. 13.80. to Point on Simms land; thence N. 52 W. 19.12 along his line to stone on Lebanon Cemetery land; thence S. 33³/₂ W. 23.48 to stone; thence along Horse Creek to beginning corner.
