 Whereas, I, H. R. Hale, Jr., am desirous of assuring my family of some means of support in any contingency, and of providing against the possibility of their becoming dependent by reason of any accident or other misfortune which may befall me at any time hereafter.
 Now know all men by these presents that I, the said H. R. Hale, Jr. in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to me in hand paid by my wife, Ann McKee Hale at and before the sealing and delivery hereof. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) do hereby acknowledge and declare that I am now holding and that from this time forth I will hold the property listed upon an inventory or schedule hereto annexed and marked "Exhibit A" and made a part of this declaration of trust to and for the following uses and trusts, to wit:

(1) In trust to hold the legal title to said property and to all other real and personal property which at any time hereafter may constitute any portion of said trust fund; to have the general control and management thereof; to keep said property invested in the same manner as at present; or to sell the same and reinvest the proceeds of such sales in such property or securities, real or personal, as I may deem expedient and at my absolute discretion from time to time and as often as I consider advisable, to change and vary investments and reinvestments; with full power and authority to let, sell, exchange and otherwise dispose of any and all real and personal property which at any time may constitute a part of said trust estate at public or private sale, with or without advertisement; also to execute good and sufficient deeds of conveyance and other necessary papers transferring the same to any purchaser thereof in fee simple or otherwise, with or without covenants of warranty, and to accept mortgages upon the whole or any part thereof to secure the payment of any portion of the purchase money therefor without responsibility upon the part of the purchaser to see to the application of the purchase money.

(2) In trust to collect the rents, profits and income accruing upon said trust estate; to demand and receive payment of all principal and interest when due, and in default of payment to take all lawful means for the recovery thereof by suit, attachment, distress and any other method, and

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
