I, W. G. Buff, of said County, a citizen of the same, do hereby acknowledge that I have received from the County and the State of South Carolina, the sum of one dollar, and other valuable considerations to receive hereinafter paid by the favor of Summerville, a Municipal Corporation situated in the County and State aforesaid, and receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
I hereby grant unto the said favor of Summerville, with successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to pass and repass upon the premises of land, (and other lands and streets in aforesaid), situated in Fairview & across High St. said City and State and bounded by the lands of Mrs. Jane S. Little, Miss Odie Richardson, Mrs. Earle H. Daniel, Mr. Lee and others.

Together with the right to enter upon, and erect, inspect, operate, replace, repair, and perpetually maintain a line of each of poles and towers with necessary wires, cross arms, guy wires, bush braces and other usual fixtures and appurtenances used as adopted for the transmission of electric current for light, heat, power, and other purpose.

Together also with the right to trim, cut and remove at any and all times such trees and bushes which in their judgment of Grantor may interfere with or damage said lines or any of their appurtenances when erected.
