(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mary R. Mock, Hattie Lee Bagwell and Joe C. Harper.
All the following three tracts or parcels of
land in said County and State, aggregating one
hundred seventy-five (175) acres, and more
particularly described by plan of a survey made
by J. A. Adams on August 23, 1912, as follows:

Tract no 1. Containing sixty-four (64) acres, beginning
at a stone 34 and running thence N. 17^o 21' 15.67 to a
stone 34, thence N. 15^o 34' 24.67 to a stone 34; thence N.
16^o E. 9.50 to a stone 34; thence N. 6^o E. 9.20 to a stone 34;
thence N. 75^o E. 9.34 to a stone 34; thence S. 64^o E. 38.82
to a stone 34; thence S. 62^o 24' 15.50 to the beginning corner.

Tract no 2. Containing sixty (60) acres, beginning at a
stone and running thence N. 6^o 3' E. 16.50 to a stone;
and thence N. 54^o 24' 38.82 to a stone; thence E. 75^o E. 15.76
to a stone 34; thence S. 5^o 14' E. 36.30 to the beginning corner.

Tract no 3. Containing fifty-one and one-half (51¹/₂)
acres, beginning at a stone 34 and running thence
N. 6^o 34' 24' 36.30 to a maple on ditch, dead and down;
thence N. 73^o E. 2.50 to a maple 34; thence S. 47^o E. 36.50 to
a stone 34, thence S. 63^o 37.50 to the beginning corner.

in the following proportions, to wit: by Mary R. Mock
