All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and on both sides of the Hawansville Road and contains 28 acres and being known as a part of tract no 3 of the sub-division of the John Owings Estate and beginning at a pine not corner in S. B. Willis line and running S. 2.17 E. 12.89 chains to a corner in the fork of the Green and Hawansville road thence S. 0. - 20 E. 8.44 chains a stake in A. G. Fisher line thence N. 80 - 35 W. 18.92 chains to a water oak at A. G. Fisher's line N. 52  $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.87 chains thence N. 8.0 E. 2.0 chains thence N. 39 E. 1.75 chains thence N. 62 1/4 E. 3.0 chains to the lower end of a small bridge coming into the Hawansville Road thence N. 46 21/4 E. 3.98 chains thence N. 9 1/2 E. 9.39 chains to the middle of the upper rail of the cement bridge on the Hawansville road thence S. 84.57 E. 12.18 chains to the beginning corner and bounded on the north side by lands of W. J. Jones and on the East by S. B. Willis and A. G. Fisher and on the south by A. G. Fisher and on the west side by the rest of tract no 3 of the John Owings Estate.
